Credit hour limit: You may register for a maximum of 6 credit hours in the Summer session; there is no minimum. The 6-credit maximum applies whether you are attending Chicago-Kent or another law school, either here or abroad. For the Summer 2008 session, two loan programs are available with different credit hour limitations: **(1) IIT University Loan** - You must take at least 6 credit hours at Chicago-Kent. **(2) Private loans** - Generally you must take at least 3 credit hours. However, some lenders offer special loans to students who take fewer than 3 credit hours. (For more details, see the section on Financial Aid on page 3 of the Registration Bulletin.) Students who register for 4 credits of clinical courses may seek permission to take a total of 7 credits by submitting a request form to Prof. Gary Laser; the forms are available in Suite 600.

CLINICAL EDUCATION COURSES

Permission is required for admission to all clinical programs. All in-house and externship clinical programs are graded on a pass/low pass/fail basis only. Students are expected to put in a minimum of 224 hours (an average of 32 hours a week for 7 weeks) for 4 hours of credit, a minimum of 168 hours (an average of 24 hours a week for 7 weeks) for 3 hours of credit, and a minimum of 112 hours (an average of 16 hours a week for 7 weeks) for 2 hours of credit. Students must be available at the days and times designated below to meet with supervising attorneys and at other times as required by the supervising attorneys.
