## CLINICAL EDUCATION COURSES

Permission is required for admission to all clinical programs. All in-house and externship clinical programs are graded on a pass/low pass/fail basis only. Students are expected to put in a minimum of 224 hours (an average of 32 hours a week for 7 weeks) for 4 hours of credit, and a minimum of 168 hours (an average of 24 hours a week for 7 weeks) for 3 hours of credit. Students must be available at the days and times designated below to meet with supervising attorneys and at other times as required by the supervising attorneys.
