Professor Sheldon Nahmod is a leading expert on constitutional law, civil rights and the law of §1983. He is the author of *Civil Rights and Civil Liberties Litigation: The Law of Section 1983* (4th ed. 1997, 2009) and has argued civil rights cases before the U.S. Supreme Court and many other federal courts. He also lectures regularly to federal judges on §1983. He is a graduate of the University of Chicago and Harvard Law School. Professor Nahmod received the Lifetime Achievement Award of the State and Local Government Law Section of the ABA for his work in §1983 jurisprudence.

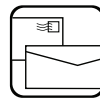
