- Over 12,000 employer organization profiles.
- Currently over 1300 job and work experience opportunity postings, including public service internships, postgraduate fellowships, and full-time positions for attorneys that range from entry level to executive level.

Additionally, PSLawNet offers an extensive, publicly available [library of career resources](#) covering topics from public service job application and search tips to practice area descriptions to a fellowship application deadline calendar.
