Mr. Wei is a lawyer for Beijing Beacon Law Firm, where his areas of practice include real estate law, construction law, internet & e-commerce law and copyright and trademark law. Some of his typical cases include the mergers and acquisitions for Chinese Construction Third Engineering Bureau and Shihao Grand hotel. Mr. Wei helped to reform ten affiliated enterprises for the National Library. He was also involved in the preparation of the construction contract for Huayin Alumina which amounted to more than 1.5 billion U.S. dollars and was Asia's largest annual product project. He also worked on the building of satellite communication network system for the National Culture Information Resource Building Management Center of the Chinese Culture Department, as well as worked on a project with Google's digital library searches in mainland China and domain name disputes and other e-commerce issues.

Mr. Wei received his Bachelor's degree in philosophy from Liaocheng Normal College in 1993. He also received a Bachelor's degree in Law from Tsinghua University in 2000. He is currently pursuing a LL.M. degree in International and Comparative Law at Chicago-Kent, in partnership with China University of Political Science and Law.

He is the Secretary-General of the Information Network and E-commerce Legal Issue Committee of the Beijing Bar Association (BBA). He also acted as a representative of the BBA in Melbourne, Australia.
