For over a year and a half, Mr. Stolzenbach was an attorney at Michael Havers, Attorney and Notary, in Berlin. At Michael Havers, he prepared civil law suits in trade law, drafted real estate contracts and took part in trial litigation. He also worked as a legal consultant for a private theatre company and researched in the areas of copyright, trademark, and internet law. Previous to his time at Michael Havers, and as part of his clerkship, Mr. Stolzenbach was a legal advisor at the head office of the holding company for the Berlin International Film Festival, where he analyzed draft and copyright law. He also worked for the legal department of the Federal Cultural Foundation as part of his clerkship.

Mr. Stolzenbach studied at the University of Regensburg, Germany and continued his legal education in 2001 at University of Cologne, Germany, where he specialized in Conflicts of Law, European Law and International Finance and Trade Law. He also took the first State Examination in Law (“Erstes Staatsexamen”). Starting in 2003, Mr. Stolzenbach had a clerkship and sat for the second state examination (“Zweites Staatsexamen”) in law. In 2005, he received qualification as a lawyer, judge or prosecutor. He continued on to the Institute of the German Bar Association, where he specialized in copyright and media law, and focused on open source and open content licensing. He is currently pursuing an LL.M in International Intellectual Property Law at Chicago-Kent College of Law.

Mr. Stolzenbach is licensed to practice in Germany and is a member of Berlin Bar Association. He is also a member of the German-Spanish Lawyers’ Association and the German-American Lawyers’ Association. Mr. Stolzenbach speaks German, Spanish, and English and has basic knowledge of French.
