Ms. Xia has been a lawyer with the Guangdong Sunny Law Firm since 1999. She has acted as legal counsel of companies and provided the following legal services: draft and revise bylaws and various contracts (including joint venture, acquisition, asset and stock assignment, transaction, non-disclosure, employment, licensing, leasing, purchases and sales, mortgage etc). Ms. Xia has given lectures on Chinese contract law, protection of consumer rights and interests in China, and legal issues regarding unfair competition within China.

Ms. Xia has also resolved numerous disputes through arbitration and settlement. She has handled a broad range of legal disputes through litigation including personal injury actions, contract controversies (with respect to loans, lending, leasing, construction projects, etc.), torts, infringements, real estate, and construction defects.

Ms. Xia acted upon different courts' designation as a member of the liquidation team (an identity similar to trustee) and the supervision team (an identity similar to debtor in possession) in numerous bankruptcy cases. In these capacities, Ms. Xia convened creditor meetings, was in charge of on going operation of business and distribution of property of the estate, oversaw claim petition from creditors and decided whether claims were allowable, as well as drafting periodical and *sui generis* report (if necessary) to the court etc.

Ms. Xia received her Bachelor's of Law from Wuhan University in 1994 and a LL.M. in International Intellectual Property Law from Chicago-Kent College of Law. She is currently pursuing an LL.M. in Financial Service Law at Chicago-Kent. Ms. Xia has been licensed to practice in China and admitted to be a member of the Zhuhai Bar Association.
