After an introduction to the legal basics, we will discuss peace keeping organisations (UNO, OSCE), trade organisations such as the WTO or Bretton Woods Institutions, humanitarian organisations (ICRC) and international organisations concerned with intellectual property and culture (UNESCO, WIPO).
