

## **Information about Tuition - 2009**

Tuition for the entire one year academic program is outlined in your acceptance letter, which you have already received. Any scholarship awarded in your acceptance letter will be deducted from your tuition. **Tuition for Fall Semester 2009 is due no later than Friday August 28th, 2009.** If you will study at Chicago-Kent for one academic year (two semesters) your tuition will be divided into two payments. In addition, if you will study at Chicago-Kent for one academic year (two semesters) you can enroll in a 9 month payment plan that divides your total due tuition into 9 monthly payments. You can enroll in this program during orientation week.

Tuition can be paid directly to the Bursars Office or Online. Online payment instructions will be given to you during orientation. You can pay your tuition by check, cash, credit card, or wire transfer. Please note that after arriving in the United States, it can take several weeks to establish a bank account and receive your “debit” card and/or paper cheques. We suggest you bring a Visa/Mastercard/American Express credit card to pay your tuition payment due August 28th, 2009, as you may not yet have an American bank account by this date.

If you fail to pay your tuition by the due date, your account will receive a “registration hold.” A “hold” means that you will not be able to register for any further classes, order transcripts, and conduct other university business. In addition, you will be charged a late fee for every month your tuition remains past due. **You will not be permitted to sit for exams unless your tuition is paid in full.**

**Please also note that if you fail to return the appropriate immunization forms (see document 11), you will receive an additional “hold” from the Student Health Services. This Health Services “hold” will prevent you from registering for classes, ordering transcripts, and conducting other university business.**
