

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING
THE FINANCIAL AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT (LL.M.)**

Chicago-Kent College of Law, Illinois Institute of Technology

In order to obtain a student visa, you must fully complete both sides of the enclosed Financial Affidavit of Support. The Financial Affidavit of Support must meet the following requirements:

Section I: You must fully complete this section and sign your name to certify that you have read the Financial Affidavit and that you understand its terms and conditions. Be sure to provide the name of your sponsor.

Section II: Your sponsor must complete and sign Section II. This section requires your sponsor to guarantee financial support for a minimum of \$4,000 for the period of time during which you will be a student at Chicago-Kent College of Law, Illinois Institute of Technology.

Section III: There are two different ways to complete this section:

1. A governmental or bank official must complete Section III to show that your sponsor has the minimum required amount of funds available for your financial support, and that these funds can be transferred and are free from government restrictions. This section must bear the seal and signature of a governmental or bank official.

OR

2. You must attach to the Financial Affidavit of Support, a bank statement of account indicating that your sponsor has the minimum required amount of funds available for your financial support, and that these funds can be transferred and are free from government restrictions. This statement must bear the seal and signature of a governmental or bank official and cannot be more than 6 months old.

After you have completed every section of the financial affidavit, return it to the *Office of International Law and Policy, Chicago-Kent College of Law, Illinois Institute of Technology, 565 West Adams Street, Suite 320B, Chicago, Illinois 60661 U.S.A.*
