

**FINANCIAL AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT (LL.M.)
International Law, Summer Program**

Chicago-Kent College of Law, Illinois Institute of Technology

This form is not a requirement of admission but is required of all full-time non-U.S. students, except permanent residents, before an immigration form can be issued.

U.S. immigration regulations require that F or J visa holders must provide certification of evidence that they will have adequate funds to meet expenses involved in a proposed program of study. The affidavit of support for the first year must have the sponsor's guarantee of support and the third section must bear the seal and signature of a governmental or bank official, or a seal and signature on a bank statement of account (no more than 6 months old) attached to the affidavit stating that the funds can be transferred. An I-20 cannot be issued until an acceptable financial affidavit and certification have been received by IIT.

You (or your spouse) should not expect to obtain employment (unless you are a graduate student awarded an assistantship, fellowship, or scholarship by your department). F and J visa holders are not authorized to work off campus for 9 consecutive months, except under emergency circumstances which arise after the student has enrolled. If you are married and bring your spouse and children, you will need to provide additional proof of funding: \$4,000 for spouse, \$2,000 for child. Spouses of F-1 students are not permitted to work under any circumstances.
