Chicago-Kent College of Law is accepting entries through August 1, 2007, for a new writing competition that will acknowledge an outstanding article or book published on a topic exploring the tension between civil liberties and national security in contemporary American society. The winner will receive a cash stipend of \$10,000.

The article or book must be in draft form or have been published within six months after February 1, 2007. As a condition of accepting the award, the winner will present his or her work at Chicago-Kent. All reasonable expenses will be paid.
