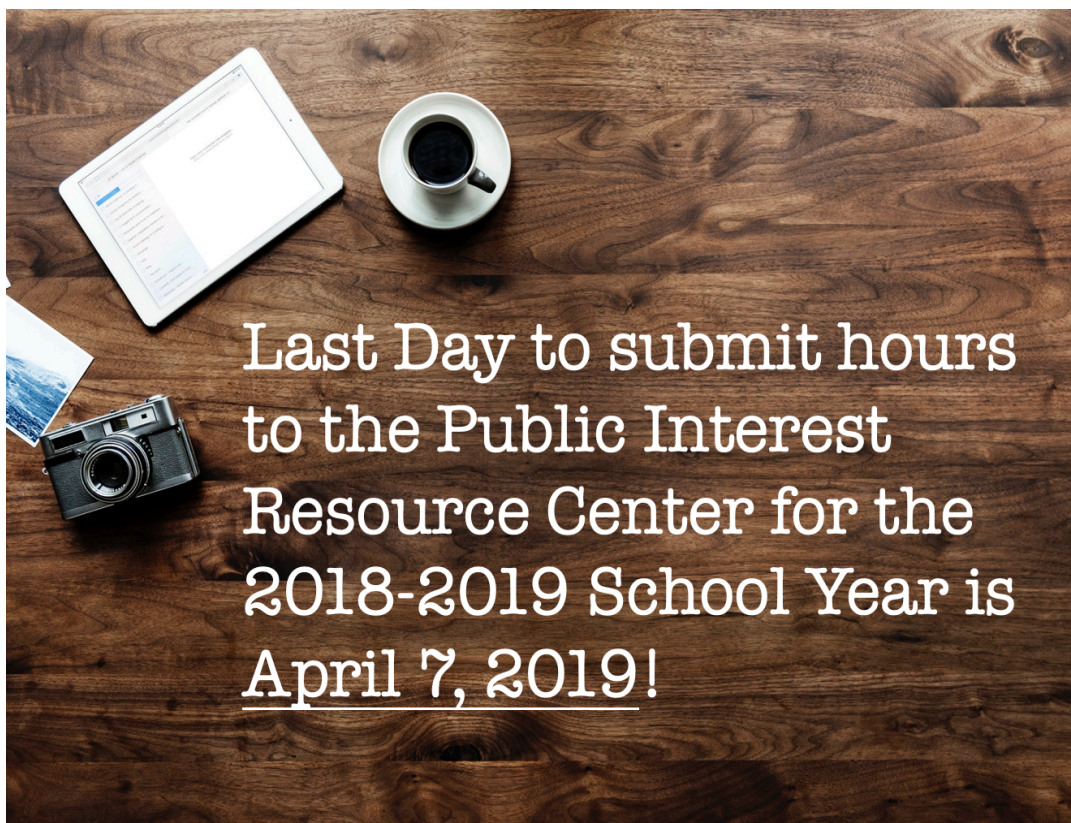

### Justice John Paul Stevens Public Interest Summer Fellowship Program

The Justice John Paul Stevens Public Interest Summer Fellowship Program in 2019 will provide a grant of \$7,000 per student to two students at Chicago-Kent College of Law who have secured unpaid public interest legal positions during the summer. These Fellowships will be awarded to help defray living expenses of deserving and committed students working in the public interest, as well as to provide much-needed legal assistance to public interest organizations.
