Approved March 1, 2009**

Current Constitutional Language

SBA By-Laws: Article V, Sec. 4. Time for Voting

“Voting will take place from 10:00 am, to 2:00p.m. and from 3:30 to 7:45 p.m. on the prescribed dates of the election.”

Revised Proposed Constitution Language

SBA By-Laws: Article V, Sec. 4. Time for Voting

“The time for voting in the SBA election shall be left to the discretion of the SBA Election Chair, such that there shall be ample time for day and evening students to vote, subject to veto by the SBA Board of Governors.”

**SBA Constitution Amendments
Approved April 5, 2009**

New Proposed Constitution Amendment

Repeal of Art. VII Sec. 4 – 1L Elections Time for voting, which currently reads
“Voting will take place from 10:00am, to 2:00p.m. and from 3:30 to 7:45p.m. on the prescribed dates of the election.”

New Proposed Constitution Language

Art. IV Sec. 4 (a)(ix)

“The President shall hold a minimum of one open office hour per week in the Student Bar Association’s office in order to make him or herself available to the student body to discuss relevant issues.

New Proposed Constitution Language

Art. IV Sec. 4(b)(vii)

“The Day Vice President shall hold a minimum of one open office per week in the Student Bar Association’s office between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. in order to make him or herself available to his or her section to discuss relevant issues.”

New Proposed Constitution Language

Art. IV Sec. 4(b)(viii)

“The Evening Vice President shall hold a minimum of one open office per week in the Student Bar Association’s office between 4 a.m. and 9 p.m. in order to make him or herself available to his or her section to discuss relevant issues.”

New Proposed Constitution Language

Art. IV Sec. 4 (b)(vi)

“The Evening Vice President shall attend and participate in all executive board meetings and report to the Board of Governors on all issues relevant to the Student Bar Association’s business.”

New Proposed Constitution Language

Art. IV Sec. 4(a)(viii)

“The President and the Assistant Dean of academic administration and student affairs shall hold a meeting once a month, during the academic school year, that is open to all student organizations leaders, in order to discuss relevant issues.”
